## SR MARY HYACINTH ROCHE SCHOLARSHIP

In the spirit of Sr Mary Hyacinth Roche's leadership, the successful applicant will be the student who best demonstrates to the Selection Committee evidence of their sense of community, discipline and commitment in their endeavours.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- 1. Candidates must be the daughter/granddaughter of an ex-student of Mount St Benedict College.
- 2. The ex-student applying for the Scholarship for their daughter/granddaughter must be a financial member of Mount St Benedict College Ex-Students Association (MSBESA).
- 3. The mother/grandmother of the successful scholarship recipient is willing to attend MSBESA Committee meetings. The Committee conducts four evening meetings per school year at the College.
- 4. It is expected that the successful recipient will be an active member in the life of the College.
- 5. Students will have received a letter of acceptance of enrolment for the Year 7 academic year.
- 6. Applicants will need to register for Level 1 of the A.C.E.R. examination, which is held in the first half of the year prior to entry.

### Responsibilities of the successful scholarship holder

- 1. MSBESA Committee membership is a condition of award of the Sr Mary Hyacinth Roche Scholarship. The Committee meets four times per year, and it is expected that the mother/grandmother of the Scholarship Holder will attend Committee meetings whilst her daughter/granddaughter is in receipt of the Scholarship.
- 2. It is expected that the successful Scholarship recipient will be an active member in the life of the College.

### Note

Students will be shortlisted based on their application and may be invited to attend an interview at the College with the Selection Committee which consists of the Principal, Registrar and MSBESA representative(s).

The defining criteria will not be academic success, though this may be considered.
